

The REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals) legislation will have major implications for companies within the UK and EU that produce, import or use chemical substances. Under this legislation companies will have to Register the chemicals they use, and for the more dangerous substances will also have to carry out a Chemical Safety Assessment and produce a Chemical Safety Report outlining the conditions under which the substance can be used safely. Substances that have certain hazardous properties may also be subject to an Authorisation process.
